# GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1) We regret that no horse may enter the show without an up to date horse flu vaccination and AHS vaccination (Batch and date details MUST be on the online entry form) This is in accordance with SAEF Rule Appendix VR/9/7/1: Horses MUST be inoculated by a VETERINARIAN within a period of 12 months of the date of the previous inoculation for AHS and 6 months from the date of the previous flu vaccination – otherwise the inoculation will be deemed to have expired.
- 2) Passports must be presented to the Show Secretary ASAP upon arrival at the GRC premises. Horse without correct vaccinations will be required to vacate the premises immediately.
- 3) It is compulsory that ALL pets are on leashes AT ALL TIMES. Animal owners found in contradiction will be fined R150 per unsecured animal.
- 4) It is mandatory for ALL riders to wear protective headgear on GC premises.
- 5) No cheques will be accepted.
- 6) NO refunds will be made in respect of cancellations and scratching after the closing date of entries.
- 7) It is the competitor's responsibility to check whether their entries have been received.
- 8) The final program will be posted by email 24 hours before commencement of the show
- 9) Please note that only the starting time is exact for the day.
- 10) Please note that the organizing committee reserves the right to combine, vary, divide or cancel classes if insufficient entries are received. Should the status of a show change due to unforeseen circumstances entries will not be refunded.
- 11) Insofar as possible the programme and conditions relating thereto will be adhered to. However, the Organising Committee reserves the right to make alterations in the event of unfavourable weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances. Should the show be cancelled or postponed for any reason, only entry fees will be refunded.
- 12) SAEF, SASJ, SASA, SAEQA, DSA or the GRC, the Organizers or any officials appointed by these shall in no way be held responsible for any damage, loss, injury sustained by owners, competitors, members of the public or any other persons or their property at GRC for the duration of the show.
- 13) By entering a stallion at GRC, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
  - a) Competition stallions remain the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the stallion.
  - b) It is the responsibility of the owner & rider to ensure that the stallion cannot exit the stable allocated to it on its own/or with the help of another horse or uninformed person
  - c) The stallion may only be removed from the stable during the show for exercise & preparation/competition & only in the presence of a responsible handler/rider.
  - d) All stallions must wear a yellow tag on their bridle at all times.
- 14) Under NO circumstances is the covering of mares allowed to take place at the GRC premises.

- 15) By entering a horse that kicks at the GRC, the competitor & owner agree to the following conditions & agree to abide by the following protocol:
  - a) The pony/horse must wear a red ribbon in its tail at all times. RIBBONS MUST BE REMOVED WHILE COMPETING IN THE SHOWING ARENA.
  - b) The pony/horse remains the responsibility of the owner & rider at all times & they are expected to have public liability against any loss, injury or damage that might be caused by the pony/horse.
- 16) Jumping rules: Please see schedule for jumping class rules
- 17) Dressage riders not presenting themselves to the judge within five minutes of their riding time will forfeit their entry and that class
- 18) The GRC reserves the right to implement any rule/regulations it deems necessary or on the advice of a veterinarian (State or Private) to control the spread of any disease. ALL competitors will be obliged to adhere to such rules/regulations at all times.
- 19) The graded arenas at the club are closed from the closing date of entries. This EXCLUDES the warm-up arenas.
- 20) The Show Holding Body of the GRC reserves the right to limit entries, depending on the total number of entries received per class.
- 21) Temporary discipline members do not earn any grading points, Victor Ludorum or Rider Ranking points.
- 22) GRC Reserves the right to alter prize money according to the number of starters in each show jumping class.



**COVID 19 RULES & REGULATIONS APPLICABLE TO ALL DISCIPLINES:**

(Discipline specific Covid rules and regulations are detailed separately per discipline in this schedule.)

All persons entering the venue agree to comply with all SA Government, Minister of Sport and SAEF Covid-19 lockdown regulations.

This document must be read in conjunction with the SAEF sport ready, safe sport resumption Covid-

19 document.

All show holding bodies must comply with the government gazette and approved SAEF sport ready document, as issued by SAEF and set out on the SAEF website [www.saef.org.za](http://www.saef.org.za) by submitting your entry you agree to comply with all such regulations.

Riders may only be accompanied by 2 additional persons (driver/groom/instructor). Riders under the age of 18 may have a 3<sup>rd</sup> person in attendance (guardian/parent).

No spectators and no members of the public will be allowed access to the venue.

Riders are required to arrive at the venue no more than 45 minutes before their allotted time slot.

This allows enough time to offload and tack up to be ready for their class.

Riders and accompanying persons are required to leave the venue within 30 minutes after the end of their final round.

A Covid 19 compliance officer will be appointed.

All riders and their accompanying persons must submit their Covid 19 self-assessment form as attached, duly completed and signed, on arrival at the gate

A new form must be handed in for each day of attendance – no form, no entry.

Anyone entering the venue is required to complete the form including officials, medics, judges, riders, instructors, staff and grooms, failing which, entry to the venue will be denied.

You have to allow your temperature to be taken and recorded on the form, your hands to be sanitized and you must have a mask.

There will be limited supply of blank forms at the gate should you forget to bring yours but this will cause a delay in your entry to the venue. These forms are used to compile a detailed attendance register which GRC is required to submit, within 24 hours of the end of the show, and which must include all details of each person entering the venue for contact tracing purposes and must keep such document for 6 months after each show.

Please cooperate to help us meet this requirement.

Any person who is suspected to have been in contact with an infected person or who has an elevated temperature or any other symptom, will be refused entrance and advised to leave the venue and self-isolate or contact their doctor.

More than 2 horses arriving on a single horsebox/truck will be allowed to enter and park at the designated area, however the riders themselves will not be granted access until 45 minutes before their slot. Please only bring the minimum number of grooms.

The social distancing requirement for individuals and riders on horseback is 2m.

For parked horseboxes, social distancing requirement is 5m.

Please tack up and untack close to your vehicle/horsebox so as to respect social distancing requirements.

Riders will only be allowed into each warm up arena immediately preceding their round/class and a maximum of 5 horses will be allowed in the warm up arenas at any point in time.

Riders and horses must return to their horsebox in-between rounds and for purposes of cooling down their horses.

Where applicable, GRC will supply course builders for the main and warm up arenas, only GRC staff may touch or make any adjustments to the jumps and course.

Masks are to be worn at all times except when mounted on a horse. This includes grooms, instructors, parents and officials.

Riders must provide their grooms with disposable gloves when accessing water taps or wash bays.

No socializing, congregating, spectating nor gathering will be permitted.

Riders and grooms waiting for their next class, must return to the parking area to wait next to their horseboxes.

Riders and their accompanying persons are required to leave the venue 30 minutes after their last round.

No hospitality or other functions are allowed.

Hired toilet facilities with janitor facilities will be available.

Medics will be on duty.

Although placings will be awarded, not prize giving will take place after each class.

If rosettes are awarded, they must be collected from a designated area.

Prize money will be paid by EFT or credited to a members account.

Results will be published online.

Where applicable, course walking is allowed before each class, subject to 2m social distancing requirements and masks must be worn.

A maximum of 150 people are allowed at the venue at any point in time, including officials, instructors, riders, grooms, drivers, staff and parents.

Neither SAEF, SASJ, SAEQA, ESA, DSA, SASA, GRC nor any of their committee or staff members accept any responsibility for any judge, competitor, official, groom, driver, parent, rider or instructor that may contract covid 19 at any graded or ungraded show or exercise, training or practice sessions, including open days and ride and go events.

All persons entering the venue do so at their own risk.

All entries are at the risk of the competitor and their accompanying persons.

Compliance officers are responsible for ensuring that the correct and latest covid protocols, procedures and guidelines are adhered to.

Note: SAEF insurance will not cover anyone should a person contract covid 19 whilst attending/participating in a show hosted by the approved show holding body.

All persons entering the venue accept responsibility for their own health and safety and for that of others and for complying with these regulations.

**WE REQUEST THAT EVERYONE PLEASE RESPECT THE MEASURES PUT IN PLACE BY GRC FOR EVERYONES HEALTH AND SAFETY. PLEASE BE RESPECTFUL OF ALL STAFF MEMBERS AND VOLUNTEERS.**

GRC recognizes its obligations to implement the statutory requirements imposed on it, specifically those relating to Covid 19. GRC has the obligation to deny access or to remove anyone from the venue who does not meet all covid 19 requirements and guidelines.

*SATURDAY – SASA CLASSES, NOVICE GRADED & OPEN GRADED SHOWING CLASSES*

*SUNDAY – IN HAND CLASSES, WORKING RIDING AND WORKING HUNTER*

Held under the auspices of Showing South Africa. All SASA & SAEF Veterinary Rules will apply.

Horse and/or riders may be tested for the presence of prohibited substances in accordance with the applicable rules and regulations.

All competitors (riders/owners/horses) in OPEN & NOVICE classes have to be registered with SASA, SAEF & a recognized club. Competitors in recreational or development classes do not have to be members of SASA but must be registered with SAEF. NOTE: All temporary members/recreational members agree to, and are bound by all SASA rules/regulations as well as all Covid-19 protocols/procedures.

**A hard hat with 3-point harness is compulsory for all working riding and working hunter classes.**

In the event of unforeseen circumstances, the Organisers reserve the right to cancel, combine & restrict classes. The program will be adhered to as far as possible.

**Registration: all competitors (riders/owners/horses) in Novice and Open classes must be registered with SASA, SAEF & SAEF Affiliated club or must pay R90 temporary membership with their entry fee.** Temporary members will not earn grading or Victor Ludorum points. Membership with SASA is available at <http://www.showingsa.co.za> or from [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za)

**SASA EDT scheme will pay all entry fees for all classes for registered members of the SASA EDTS scheme.** EDTS application forms, rules & conditions are available at <http://www.showingsa.co.za> or [admin@showingsa.co.za](mailto:admin@showingsa.co.za)

*Registered EDTS in graded or SASA riding horse classes will earn National SASA EDTS Victor Ludorum points.*

*Registered SASA Instructors will earn National SASA Instructor Victor Ludorum points for all their pupils in graded SASA Riding Horse classes.*

Any rider wishing to compete as an adult at this show may do so as long as they have reached their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday by the 1<sup>st</sup> day of the show. They may then ride again as a junior from the next show. This is such a fabulous opportunity for the younger combinations.

No cross entries are allowed between Open & Novice classes (i.e. you may not enter Open Graded Show Riding and Novice Graded Show Hunter). Cross entries between Showing and each Working Class are allowed (i.e. Open Graded Showing and Novice Graded Working Classes) Cross entries are allowed between Novice Graded Working Classes & Open Graded Working Classes (i.e. Novice Graded Working Riding and Open Graded Working Hunter and vice versa).

Any and all decisions made by the show convenor in terms of the collation, organization and management of the show will be deemed final and no further correspondence will be entered into.

Please bring up to date passports to the showgrounds and present it to the show secretary/passport controller upon request. These will be checked before entry to the event/venue/competition is permitted. NO PASSPORT NO ENTRY.

The show convenor reserves the right to refuse entries of ponies/horses not up to date with flu and AHS vaccinations.

A substitution of pony/rider/horse will be permitted provided the correct forms are completed and signed by

all relevant parties and submitted to the show secretary no less than one hour prior to commencement of the classes(es).

Please note due to the restrictions on maximum number of riders per class (8 per pool) all showing classes will start pools as follows: as horses come in, pool 1 will be filled, followed by pool 2 etc.

The organizers reserve the right to fine/warn/suspend and/or eliminate offenders who are suspected of cruelty to the horse, or bad behaviour.

#### **COVID-19 REGULATIONS AND INDEMNITY**

**Please note that all showing events will be held under the following regulations and indemnities as per SAEF government submission 1 July 2020.**

Neither SASA nor any showing counsel accept any responsibility/liability for any judge, competitor, show official, groom, parent, driver that might contract Covid 19 at any showing show. All entries are done so at your own risk.

This document must be read in conjunction with the SAEF sport ready, safe sport resumption Covid 19 document.

All show holding bodies must comply with the government gazette and approved SAEF sport ready document.

1) All competitors, judges and officials must be members of SAEF

2) All riders, judges, officials, support staff and medics agree and confirm that they will comply with the South African government regulations and SAEF Covid 19 guidelines and protocols, as issued by SAEF and set out on the SAEF website [www.saeef.org.za](http://www.saeef.org.za), when entering a show/event.

3) Riders may only be accompanied by their groom and a driver (only if needed). The driver of the vehicle must remain in/or near the vehicle for the duration of the show. Junior and pony riders (18 years and under) may be accompanied by 1 parent or guardian. Note that the maximum number of individuals permitted at any show/venue, will be determined by the schedule supplied by SAEF for each registered venue.

**NO SPECTATORS ARE ALLOWED AND STRICT SOCIAL DISTANCING WILL BE ENFORCED.**

4) All present at the event will be required to report to the official covid 19 compliance officer on arrival. This includes grooms, parents and riders. The register will be signed, temperatures taken and recorded, hand sanitizer will be provided. Only screening (taking of temperatures) is required, not testing (as in a Covid 19 official test). All individuals must complete and submit the SAEF Covid 19 self-screening questionnaire and hand it over to the Covid 19 compliance officer.

5) The name of the relevant Covid 19 compliance officer will be published on the entry form.

6) It is **COMPULSORY** for all present to wear face masks/covering, correctly positioned, at all times.

7) Riders do not have to wear masks in the warm up arena and may compete without a mask. On completion of the class/round, riders must return to their parking spot to untack, load and vacate the venue as soon as possible. A cool down period of 15 minutes is allowed, and the rider should then leave the premises as soon as possible afterwards.

8) Horse boxes and vehicles must adhere to the regulatory distance of 5m (Five meters) apart, in demarcated parking areas

9) No prize giving will be held. All prize money will be paid electronically. A record of prize winners will be kept. Results will be posted online or provided by email. Rosettes may be placed in a designated area clearly marked for the riders attention.

These may be collected by riders, who are cautioned to wear masks and adhere to strict social distancing guidelines.

The designated area must be provided with hand sanitizer for recipients to use.

Riders are also requested not to gather at the collection point.

10) Horses will not be ridden by judges. Horses/ponies may not be stripped for the confirmation phase of the



class.

No outside assistance will be permitted in the ring at any time.

When lined up, competitors must maintain a 3.5m distance between each other.

11) Note that it is the Covid 19 compliance officers duty to determine how many competitors will be allowed to compete at a show. Any relevant Covid 19 restrictions pertaining to this, will be adhered to.

12) The show holding body and venue has taken all and every precaution, ensuring Covid 19 compliance. Please note however that the show holding body (venue), SASA and the South African Equestrian Federation (SAEF) cannot be held responsible for any person contracting Covid 19 at the respective venues. All attendees enter the venue at their own risk.

All competitors participate at their own risk.

Note that SAEF insurance will not cover anyone, should a person contract Covid 19 whilst attending/participating in a show, hosted by the approved Show Holding Body.

13) The venues appointed Covid 19 compliance officer is authorized to ask any person/attendant at the venue to leave immediately, should any of the Covid 19 regulations be contravened. No refunds will be given for entries, levies or any other costs incurred.

14) Catering may be available, provided correct Covid 19 rules are adhered to.

### **PROCEDURES TO BE ADHERED TO FOR JUDGING OF DIFFERENT CLASSES**

#### Judging of showing classes:

1) All showing classes will be run under SASA showing rules edition 21 revised 3 February 2020 (note that due to certain Covid 19 related restrictions, the points listed below, will take preference over the existing rules)

2) In all showing classes, in hand classes, SASA riding horse classes, there shall be no more than 8 competitors in the arena at any given stage.

3) This applies to the designated warm up arena as well.

4) In the event that there are more than 2 pools in a class and that there needs to be a championship class run, then the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners will go forward to the championship.

5) Riders must not congregate at the entrance to the arena and must maintain the required 3.5m distance. During the go around, riders must maintain the minimum of 3.5m distance from the horse in front of them at all times.

6) Competitors must be lined up with a minimum of 3.5m distance between them.

7) There will be no ride by the judge in any of the classes.

8) The confirmation phase for ridden classes will be done mounted. No outside assistance is permitted in the ring.

9) The showing classes will remain with the maximum of 8 horses per pool.

10) There are no restrictions on the number of pools in a showing class, provided that it fits in with the maximum number allowed at the specific venue, which is determined by SAEF for that particular venue (e.g. A show hack class can have 2/3/4 pools)

11) The pools will still be run as a normal class, with the exception of no ride by the judge and exhibits will not be stripped for the confirmation phase of the class, unless it is an in hand class.

12) The same judge must judge all pools within a particular class.

13) On completion of the judging of the pool, judges will call into line the competitors, lining them up in an order of 1 to 8 or part thereof. No prizes/rosettes are awarded.

14) Once all pools of a specific class have been completed, then only, the combinations that were pulled in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> in each of the relevant pools, will go forward to a separate class. This class must take place straight after the qualifying pools (it is unlikely that there would be more than 4 pools of horses/ponies so this class would still not exceed the maximum number of 8 competitors allowed in the ring at once.)

15) Horses/ponies will only do the go around phase in this class. No test or confirmation will be done.

16) The judge will then call them in order of preference and this will be the final result of the class.

1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> for 2 pools, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> for 3 pools and so on.

17) These prize winners will receive rosettes and points as per what is stipulated in the SASA rules. As per rule 50.9.2 (no rosettes/prize money are handed out to the competitors and judges must still maintain distance when congratulating competitors).

18) Where there is only 1 pool of horses/ponies then the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> will be placed and receive points as per rule 50.9.3 and it will not be necessary to hold a separate class.

19) In Novice classes points will be awarded as per rule 52.2.2

**Judging of working hunter classes:**

1) Competitors may walk the course. Pony riders and juniors may be accompanied by 1 person. Masks must be worn while walking and social distancing must be adhered to.

2) After each class, the jumps/uprights that have been handled to adjust heights for the different classes will need to be sanitized prior to the commencement of the following class.

3) Competitors will enter the arena 1 at a time, to jump their round. They will then leave the arena to remove the horses boots and immediately return, mounted, to complete their confirmation phase.

4) There will be no ride by the judge.

5) There will be no pools in this class.

**Judging of Working Riding classes:**

1) Competitors working riding tests will be placed on a suitable notice board at the show arena prior to the start of the class.

2) Competitors will enter the arena 1 at a time to do their test.

On completion of their test, they will remain in the arena to do their confirmation phase, mounted.

There will be no ride by the judge.

3) Where possible there should preferably not be any objects that need to be picked up/handled by the competitor during the test. If, however, this is incorporated, the item must be sanitized after each competitor has completed that movement.

4) This class will not be divided into pools.

No prize giving will be held after any of the classes held on the day at the show. Any prize money will be paid electronically. A record of prize winners will be kept. Results will be posted online or provided by email.

**Competitors are asked to be respectful of all involved, as well as respecting the serious implications of not adhering to government Covid 19 interventions and regulations.**

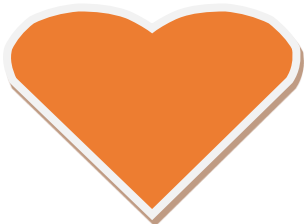
